

## Paint Bodacious Blooms Workshop – Supply List

### Outside the Box Studio

Please bring:

3 - 5 **pre-gessoed** stretched canvases, canvas panels or wood panels  
(No smaller than 12” x 12” and no larger than 20” x 20” – horizontal, vertical or square formats are all great!)

An assortment of acrylic paints. Colors you’ll need for sure are:

- Titanium white – or similar
- Mars Black – or similar
- Ultramarine Blue, Pthalo Blue, Prussian Blue or French Blue
- Cadmium Yellow Medium - or similar
- Cadmium Yellow Light - or similar
- Cadmium Orange – or similar
- Naphthol Red – or similar
- Sap Green – or similar
- Quinacridone Magenta

Any other colors that you love! I’ll have an assortment for you to use as well. Please be sure to buy colors that aren’t already mixed with white (look creamy or pastel).

I use either Nova Acrylics, Golden Acrylics or Charvin. However, you are more than welcome to bring whatever you have/like. Heavy or medium weight acrylics are good, but fluid acrylics are too runny. to bring whatever you have/like.

A variety of acrylic painting brushes – Up to 2” wide and down to a #2. Flat brushes work the best, but bring whatever you feel most comfortable using. These do NOT need to be high quality brushes! I buy Qualita Taklon Long Handled Flat brushes. I’ll have some brushes for you to use as well.

Palette paper – or whatever you like to use for your palette.

Roll of paper towels

An assortment of collage papers – if you’d like

A sketch pad

A graphite pencil

Mark-making tools – (I will have all of these on hand as well, so just bring what you have. No need to buy new!) Woodies, graphite, art crayons like U.S. Art Supply Super Crayons Set of 36 Colors - Smooth Easy Glide Gel Crayons (found on Amazon) or Marabu Mixed Media Art Crayons (found on Amazon, Jerry’s Artarama or Dick Blick). The U.S. Art Supply set (found on Amazon) is the least expensive and they work great!

An apron or shirt to paint in

A charged cell phone to take photos

Any snacks or drinks you might want – I’ll have chocolate and bubble gum of course!

A sense of humor and willingness to explore!
